## Introduction

The Townshend Family provides a link between the Thomas and Casebourne families during the canal building era in the UK in the late 18<sup>th</sup> and early 19<sup>th</sup> centuries.

It seems almost certain that the four Townshends (identified below) were siblings, judging by various clues contained in the Thomas Townshend Thomas diaries, newspaper articles, obituaries and various other sources. It is not known who their parents were, their respective ages (at least with any accuracy) or indeed whether there were any other siblings.

1. **Elizabeth Townshend** - born about 1767 - married William Thomas 15.10.1786 (Halifax registers). Died 6.8.1842. William and Elizabeth were my 3 x great grandparents. William and Elizabeth had 11 children of whom the following are relevant to the Townshend story were
    - (a) John Thomas - Baptised 25.12.1787. Engineer (see notes below) - married Catherine daughter of Richard Townshend 19.12.1839. Died 5.1.1844. John was the Resident Engineer at Sheerness Dockyard.
    - (b) Thomas Townshend Thomas (TTT) - Born 4.5.1794. Baptised 1.7.1794. Woolstapler - my 2 x great grandfather. Wrote diaries in 1830-40s giving some clues on the family.
    - (c) Catherine Thomas - Baptised 28.6.1814 - married Richard Herbert Townshend (see notes below)
  
  2. **Thomas Townshend** - born about 1771. Prominent engineer working on canals and railways from the 1790s to 1840s. Married Eleanor (an IGI record submitted by an LDS member records a marriage with Elinor Herbert in 1804 in Meath, Ireland) and TTT's diaries record the funeral of Eleanor in Birmingham in November 1837. Thomas died on 3.5.1846. See further notes below.
  
  3. **Richard Townshend** - Not known when born. His Wife was Hannah (based on TTT's diaries) who was born in Ireland (1841 census). Their son was named Richard Herbert Townshend so it is possible that she was a Herbert and possibly Eleanor's sister. Richard died in 1818 as a result of an accident whilst returning from Peterborough Market to where he was working on the Eau Brink Drainage (The Hull Packet and Original Weekly Commercial, Literary and General Advertiser - 3.11.1818). His christian name is known from the marriage certificates of children.

Thei children relevant to story are

    - (a) Richard Herbert Townshend - born 4.1.1807 in Ireland (Obituary in proceedings of ICE). Another prominent engineer. Married Catherine Thomas (his cousin) in 1839 amid some family friction.
    - (b) Catherine Townshend - born about 1806 in Wigan, married her cousin John Thomas on 19.12.1839.

4. Sarah Townshend - born about 1772 (based on age of 63 recorded in TTT's diaries in 1835). She married Adam Casebourne 24.2.1797. She died in 1835. Her death was recorded by TTT in his diaries with entry on 1st April, 1835 "My Aunt Casebourne died aged 63". Children relevant to story
- (a) Thomas Casebourne - born Hemel Hempstead 1797. Civil engineer (see notes below).

Further notes as evidence of how individuals are linked.

The Biographical Dictionary of Civil Engineers records:-

- (a) Thomas Townshend - states that he worked with his brother in Ireland but his brother died whilst working on the Eau Brink Drainage in 1818. In 1810-11 he was working in Ireland and was assisted by his relative John Thomas.
- (b) Thomas Casebourne - trained as a civil engineer almost certainly by his uncle Thomas Townshend.

Obituaries in the ICE proceedings also show

- (a) Richard Townshend (younger) - His father's death in 1818 necessitated an early entrance into professional work and accordingly commenced his pupilage in the office of his relative (cousin) John Thomas resident engineer at Sheerness. After leaving Sheerness he continued in the office of his uncle Thomas Townshend and his cousin John Thomas.

**4. [938] Richard<sup>2</sup> TOWNSHEND** (*Unknown*<sup>1</sup>), died 1818. He married Hannah. Hannah died 27 Jan 1845.

Richard is named on Richard Herbert's marriage certificate as being his father. According to the obituary of Richard Herbert (proceedings of the Institution of Civil Engineers) Richard (the father) died in 1818 whilst "professionally employed on the Eau Brink and Fen Drainage Works".  
presumably an accident.

Extract from The Hull Packet and Original Weekly Commercial, Literary and General Advertiser of 3rd Nov 1818 gave some account

"On Saturday se'nnight, at night, as Mr Townsend, a gentleman engaged in the Eau Brink Drainage, was returning home from Peterbrough Market, he was accidentally thrown from his horse near Whittlesea and, melancholy to relate, killed on the spot."

Hannah Townshend is named in John Thomas' will (John b. 1787) as being Catherine's (his wife) mother. Hannah is also shown as living with John and Catherine at Highgate in the 1841 census.

Census: 1841, Halifax, age 45y; 1851, Halifax, age 56y. He married Elizabeth AUTY 30 Dec 1821, in Kirkheaton Parish Church. She was the daughter of William AUTY and Hannah HOLT. Elizabeth AUTY was born 1800, in Kirkheaton, christened 21 Sep 1800, in Kirkheaton, died 9 May 1866, in Halifax, Yorkshire, buried 12 May 1866, in Sion Chapel - grave plot 836. Census: 1841, Halifax, age 40y; 1851, Halifax, age 50y; 1861, Halifax, age 60y.

Thomas Townshend Thomas was a Woolstapler by profession and contemporary trade directories show his business premises being at 57 Woolshops, Halifax between 1837 - 1847.

In 1853 the address is given as 67 Woolshops (possibly an error). In 1858 apparently they were in the Square. In 1837 his home address was given as Wade Street, from 1845 onwards it was Church Street, Halifax.

1841 census for Wade Street 1851 census for 6 Church Street, Halifax

Thomas Townsend Thomas died at his home, 28 Church Street, on the 7th June 1859 from "Disease of the Stomach and Liver". He was 65 years old. (John Thomas, presumably his eldest son, was in attendance). He was buried at Sion Chapel
