Notes for family of William HAIGH and Ann BUTLER: Here lieth interred the body of Mary Haigh, daughter of William Haigh of Southowram, who departed this life on 22nd day of July, 1804 in the 4th year of her age. Also of Nancy Haigh, wife of the abovenamed William Haigh, who departed this life 10th Sept 1819 aged 50 years. John Haigh, the son of Charles and Martha Haigh of Southm. grandson to William Haigh who departed this life 25th May 1826 aged 3 years. Also the abovenamed William Haigh who departed this life 22nd Nov 1831 aged 60 years.

Also Job Haigh, the son of the above William Haigh, who departed this life the 7th day of March 1838 aged 34 years.

Occupation: Worsted Spinner, 1834.⁴ Census: 1841, Southowram, age 40y;⁵ 1851, Southowram, age 53y.⁶ He married Martha HOLT⁸ 12 Nov 1821, in Halifax Parish Church.⁷ She was the daughter of John HOLT and Mary HOLDSWORTH. Martha HOLT was born 1797, bapt. 24 Sep 1797, died 1851-1861. Census: 1841, Southowram, age 40y;⁹ 1851, Southowram, age 54y.¹⁰

Charles probably died between 1861 and 1871. Cannot find on 1871 census.

Note on Martha: In her brother John's will she is referred to as "my late sister Matha Haigh". Her marriage to Charles Haigh taken from IGI.

Martha probably died between 1851 and 1861. 1861 census Charles is described as a widower.
