This is the last will and testament of me JOHN HOLDSWORTH the Elder of Upper Ranns in Northowram in the parish of Halifax in the county of York Serge maker made the eight day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten whereby I direct that all my debts funeral expenses and charges of proving this my will be ... paid by my Executors hereinafter named out of my Personal Estate and secondly I give and devise unto and to the ... of my eldest son JOHN HOLDSWORTH the Younger and of his heirs and assigns for ever all that piece of copyhold land lying and being in the township of Northowram aforesaid in the possession of one of my other sons SAMUEL HOLDSWORTH being the remainder and that part of the .... which I purchased of Mr. John Mitchell and remains unsold and unconveyed to the said SAMUEL HOLDSWORTH. And I give and devise and bequeath unto my sons JOHN, GEORGE, JAMES and RICHARD HOLDSWORTH and to their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns my room number twelve in the Halifax Piece Hall for all such estate and interest as I have therein as tenants in common and not as joint tenants. And I give and bequeath unto my dear wife CATHERINE in case she survives me the interest and proceeds of all my monies out at interest for and during the term of her natural life to be paid and payable to her by my said Executors as and when the same become due from my several debtors for her support in her widowhood. and from and immediately after her death I will and direct that my said executors or their survivors and survivor of them his executors and administrators do place out at interest in their or his names or name upon Government or upon real securities the full sum of one thousand two hundred pounds and pay and apply the same in manner next after mentioned that is to say First that they do pay and apply unto my daughter MARY the widow of JOHN HOLT deceased half yearly the interest and proceeds of the sum of four hundred pounds, one third part of the said sum of one thousand two hundred pounds during the term of her natural life and from and after her decease that they my said Executors do pay the same sum of four hundred pounds unto and equally amongst all her children share and share alike as and when they attain their respective ages of twenty one years and in case of the death of any of them the children of my said daughter MARY during their minorities then the share or shares of him her or them so dying to be paid to the survivors and survivor of them. Secondly that they my said executors do pay and apply unto my other daughter FANNY the wife of THOMAS HOLROYD half yearly the interest and proceeds of the like sum of four hundred pounds another third part of the said sum of one thousand two hundred pounds during the term of her natural life and from and after her decease do divide the said sum of four hundred pounds and pay the same unto and amongst all and every her children whether by her present or any future husband living at her death equally amongst them share and share alike as and when they attain their respective ages of twenty one years and in case of the death of any of them the children of my said daughter FANNY during their minorities the share or shares of him her of them so dying to be paid to the survivors and survivor of them. Provided always and my will and mind expressly is that my

said Executors shall during the lives of my said two daughters pay the said annual proceeds of the said sums of four hundred pounds and four hundred pounds as aforesaid into their own proper hands and not into the hands of any after taken husband of my said daughter MARY nor into the hands of the present or any after taken husband of my said daughter FANNY. To the Intent that the same may not be subject to the control debts or engagements of any husband of theirs but for their sole and several uses hereby declaring that the receipts of my said daughters subscribed with their own hands shall only be sufficient discharges to my said Executors for any payments to be made of the same yearly interests or either of them.
