Census: 1841, Southowram, age 30y;³ 1851, Southowram, age 40y.¹² She married Joseph HOLT 17 Dec 1831. He was the son of John HOLT and Mary HOLDSWORTH. Joseph HOLT was born 1803, in Northowram, bapt. 26 Jun 1803, in Halifax Parish Church, died 2 Jan 1880,¹³ buried 1880, in Halifax All Saints.¹⁴ Occupation: Coal Merchant, 1865. Census: 1841, Southowram, age 35y;¹⁵ 1851, Southowram, age 46y;¹⁶ 1871, age 67y.¹⁷

Cleckheaton, age 36y;⁵⁶ 1881, Hipperholme cum Brighouse, age 45y.⁵⁷ She married (1) William HAIGH 17 Feb 1857, in Halifax Parish Church.⁵⁸ He was the son of Charles HAIGH and Martha HOLT. William HAIGH was born 1832,⁵⁹ bapt. 13 May 1832, in Halifax Parish Church.⁶⁰ Census: 1841, Southowram, age 9y;³ 1851, Southowram, age 19y;⁶¹ 1861, North Bierley, age 29y;⁶² 1871, Cleckheaton, age 39y.⁶³ She married (2) George HEMINGWAY 1 Feb 1879, in Lightcliffe Parish Church.⁶⁴ He was the son of John HEMINGWAY and Ann APPELYARD. Notes for family of Mary HOLT and William HAIGH: John HOLT and Mary HOLDSWORTH were married in 1781. They had at least 11 children, 5 would produce children that would later inter-marry their cousins.

(1) Mary (bapt 1793) married James WHITELEY in 1822 - child James Holt WHITELEY (bapt. 1824). (2) Martha (baptised Sept 1797) married Charles HAIGH in 1821 - children Elizabeth Ann HAIGH (baptised 1826) and William HAIGH (baptised 1832). John THOMAS was born 31 Mar 1824, in Halifax, Yorkshire, bapt. 23 Jan 1825, in Halifax Parish Church, died 22 Sep 1906, in 48, Holdsworth Road, Halifax.⁷⁴ Occupation: 1865, New Road Halifax.⁷⁵ Census: 1841, Halifax, age 15y;⁷⁶ 1851, Halifax, age 26y;⁷⁷ 1871, Halifax, age 45y;⁷⁸ 1881, Halifax, age 55y;⁷⁹ 1891, Halifax, age 65y;⁸⁰ 1901, Halifax, age 76y.⁸¹

governess, a cook, a kitchen maid and a housemaid. She may have also employed four children, paying them with an education, free board and lodging.

Ada was a governess for much of her life. At the time that Hannah Frances Churchyard wrote her will in 1903, Ada was described as "Ada Thomas" of Vienna Austria spinster.

Ada never married and later in life she divided her time between staying with relatives and living in hotels in places such as Torquay.

Elizabeth RICHARDSON was born 28 Aug 1877, in Halifax, Yorkshire,⁸⁴ died 28 Jan 1961, in Melton, Woodbridge, Suffolk. Census: 1881, Halifax, age 3y;⁹⁹ 1891, Halifax, age 14y;¹⁰⁰ 1901, Aston, Birmingham, age 23y.¹⁰¹

John Holt Thomas (Jack) was an engineering draughtsman - he moved from Halifax in his late twenties and worked in Birmingham for the Wolseley car company.

Around 1910-15 the family moved to Suffolk where Jack worked for Ransomes Sims and Jeffries (agricultural engineers) until his retirement just before the Second World War.

He married Hilda Mary GOLDSMITH. She was the daughter of Richard George GOLDSMITH and Dora Catherine Rose WARD. Hilda Mary GOLDSMITH was born 4 Jan 1914, in Ipswich, Suffolk, died 11 May 1977, in Ipswich Suffolk. Charles was born in King's Norton (Birmingham) on 4th October, 1907. He was the youngest of three children of John Holt Thomas and Elizabeth Richardson both of whom were descended from old Yorkshire families.

Fairly shortly after his birth the family moved to Ipswich - John Holt Thomas was an engineering draughtsman and was heavily involved with the manufacture of agricultural machinery from around 1910 to his retirement just before the Second World War.

Charles went to Ipswich School and qualified as a Chartered Accountant in Ipswich. After qualifying he worked for the rest of his career with the local newspaper group (East Anglian Daily Times) as Company Secretary and latterly as a Director and the General Manager.

Charles' over-riding hobby was sailing. In the 1950s he shared an ocean racer (Brambling) with his brother-in-law who was reputed to be the best helmsman on the East Coast. They won many honours in off-shore races and they used to visit Holland and Belgium several times each year. Later when his brother-in-law died Charles built his own yacht and the family spent many a happy holiday cruising the East Coast - unfortunately cut short by his relatively early death at the age of 60 in 1968. Hilda Mary Goldsmith was born in Ipswich on 4th January, 1914 the elder daughter of Richard George Goldsmith and Dora Catherine Rose Ward. Richard was the secretary for the Foxhall Sanatorium in Ipswich.

Hilda lived all her life in Ipswich. As a girl she lived with her family in the grounds of the Sanatorium and she went to the Convent School. After leaving school she trained as a secretary and later worked at the local newspaper the East Anglian Daily Times where she met her future husband Charles Holt Thomas (who was the Company Secretary and later a Director of the newspaper company). Charles and Hilda were married on 20th February, 1943 at All Saints Church Kesgrave (near Ipswich and the Parish Church for the sanatorium where Hilda was still living at the time.
