## Goldsmith Descent

The Goldsmith family appear to have come from around the Goring/Ferring/Angmering area of Sussex. Latterly they were nearly all were connected with the sea in one form or another but it is not known how far back that goes.

The earliest Goldsmith for which we have reasonably reliable records is John Goldsmith (born around 1750). His parents may have been John Goldsmith and Hannah Clark.

John and Mary probably lived much of their life in Kingston (Ferring) and that seems to be where the 2 children (Stephen and George) that have been traced were baptised and where John was buried in 1819.

Stephen moved to Littlehampton and later to Portsmouth whilst George move to New Shoreham.

*Generation No. 1*

**1. John<sup>1</sup> GOLDSMITH**, born 1750, died 1819. He married Mary BATCHELOR 18 May 1780, in Angmering.<sup>1</sup> Mary BATCHELOR was born 1753. Census: 1841, New Shoreham, age 88y.<sup>2,3</sup>

DoB and DoD based on a burial record for John Goldsmith of Kingston, Ferring who was buried on 14/3/1819.

John's parents are probably John Goldsmith and Hannah Clark who were married at Goring in 1750.

Almost certainly Mary Batchelor - the only John Goldsmith marriage in West Sussex in the period 1750 -1790 to a Mary was the marriage in Angmering on 18 May 1780 (Sussex Marriage Index).

With her age recorded as 88 in the 1841 census probable date of birth is around 1753. There is a Mary Batchelor (stet) shown in the IGI baptised in Steyning 5 Nov 1752.



Ferring burial records show a Mary Goldsmith buried 4th June 1843 aged 90 from New Shoreham.

Census: 1841, Portsea, age 60y.<sup>15,16</sup> He married Fanny SHORT 17 Apr 1803, in St Mary's Littlehampton.<sup>17</sup> She was the daughter of George SHORT and Sarah WIDGET. Fanny SHORT was born 1780, bapt. 15 Sep 1780, in Littlehampton.<sup>18</sup>

In the 1841 census Stephen is living at Strong Buildings in Portsea aged 60 and apparently born in Hampshire. Several children are also living with him including Henry. Fanny his wife may have died by this time.

Stephen was a shipwright (both in census of 1841) and on Henry's marriage certificate of 1850 (although Stephen is in fact dead by this time).

It would appear that Stephen was born around 1780. According to the 1841 census he was born in Hampshire but the only record found so far of a Stephen Goldsmith baptism is in Ferring (W. Sussex) on 19th November 1780 to a John and Mary Goldsmith. John and Mary appear to also have had 6 other children - all baptised in Ferring - Hannah (1783), Thomas (1786), Charlotte (1788), Harriett (1791), George (1794), John (1797).

Rather suspect that she was taken on by John and Mary Franklin. In 1861 there is a Kate Eliza (aged 18) living with the Franklins at 3 Hanover street. Still living there in 1871 and 1881. By 1891 Kate is living at 5 Hanover St. In 1901 Kate is still living at 5 Hanover St and with her are James Hendy (i.e. the husband of Kate Eliza Goldsmith's mother together with some other Hendy family. In 1904 a Kate Eliza Goldsmith gets married to William Henry Vine and in the 1911 census Kate Eliza Vine is a widow living at 5 Hanover St. Finally in 1925 a Kate Eliza Vine dies in Portsmouth aged 83 (Dec 1925 Portsmouth 2b 689).

Kate Eliza Vine left a will that was proved by Sarah Kate Elsey This shows that Kate Eliza died on 31st December 1925. Sarah Kate Elsey married to Charles Frederick Elsey was prior to marriage Sarah Kate Franklin - according to the 1891 census a cousin of Kate Eliza.

We know that Henry Goldsmith's father was Stephen (from Henry's marriage certificate). However we do not know for certain that Henry's mother was Fanny. The hypothesis is as follows

Stephen Goldsmith married a Fanny Short in Littlehampton in 1803 and that (from IGI) Stephen and Fanny had 8 children baptised in Littlehampton and Portsea. Unfortunately there is no record of a baptism of Henry. However we know from the 1841 census that Joseph, Mary, Harriett and Henry were living with Stephen in Strong Buildings. Joseph and Mary were, we believe, children of Stephen and Fanny and listed in the IGI. Likewise Harriett appears to have no baptismal record but on marriage to James Hendy her father is recorded as Stephen.

Henry is believed to have had a relationship with Amelia Rebecca Savers prior to his marriage. Amelia had three children - 2 of which Rosina Amelia Goldsmith Savers and Henry Joseph Stephen Goldsmith Savers were born in 1847 and 1849 respectively

On Rosina's birth certificate there is no father's name but on Henry's it is given as Henry Goldsmith a labourer. There appears to be no marriage certificate for Henry and Amelia.
